# About Our Island Arts Center

## in the Champlain Islands, Grand Isle County Vermont

Island Arts (The Champlain Islands Celebration of the Arts, Inc.) received a beautiful, structurally sound, hundred-year-old barn in 2014. After numerous upgrades and repairs, it opened in 2019 for events, performances, workshops, and gallery exhibits. The barn's original beams, wooden floor, and cathedral ceiling make it a unique and stunning space.

Occasional leaks and traffic noise continued to intrude upon event attendees, so we decided to implement a multi-year improvement plan to address those issues.



### Phase 1-A of our improvement plan is complete!

Island Arts is delighted that the project phase to replace the leaking metal roof is complete with thanks to our generous donors, architect Doug Viehmann of Guillot Vivian Viehmann Architects (GVV), and contractor Vermont Construction Company. The new roof was enhanced with new metal roofing and acoustic insulation to ensure weather-tightness and help mitigate external noise (improving sound quality). Quiet exhaust fans were installed in the cupola to enhance air flow inside the iconic barn. Part 2 of the sound mitigation efforts will be addressed in Phase 1-B.

We have wonderful aerial videos of the work that was done for phase 1-A that we will happily share with our audience.


### Phase 1 -B Renovations to start September 2025

Our next phase of renovation includes new siding, improved accessibility, and extended soundproofing insulation around the envelope of the building. Work will resume in late summer after the end of our 2025 season of classes and events with GVV Architects and our Phase 1-B contractor Turnbaugh Construction. By next year's season, the audience, musicians, and performers will be able to enjoy superb acoustic and comfort in our well-ventilated Island Arts barn.







The event will be held at Orchard Hill Observatory in South Alburgh VT. The address is 70 Poor Farm Road, 05440. There is parking on site.


