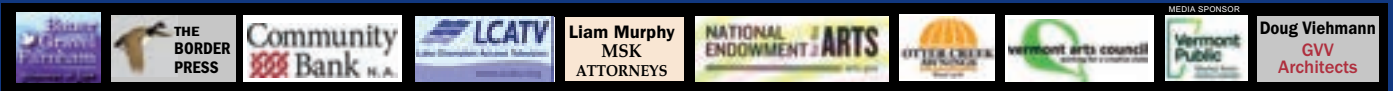

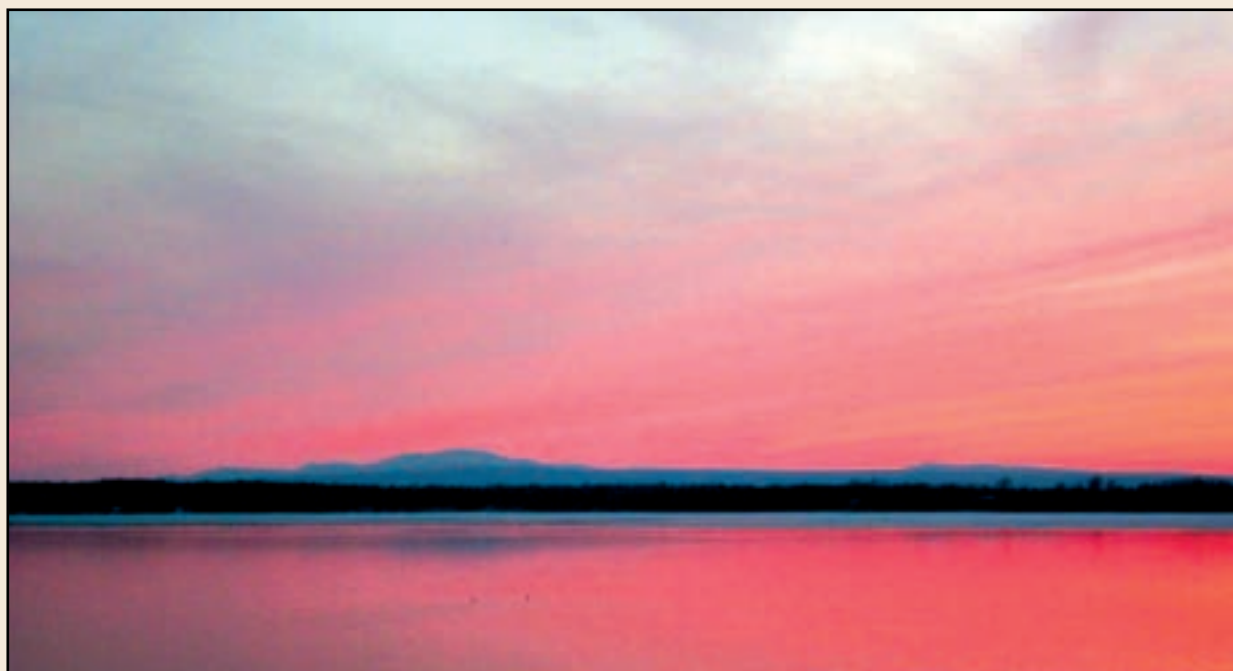

Moving simply and letting go of our own blocks allows Chi, or energy, to flow. QiGong is a method of movement from which Tai Chi and a plethora of other movements have evolved. This is a great practice for people with an active mind as well as an active body. If you are new to yoga this is a wonderful place to start.

Appalachian Flatfootin' Clogging Workshop



DATE AND TIME: Sunday, May 31, 2026; 2:00 - 3:30 pm

Flatfooting is a unique style of percussive dance that originated in the southern Appalachian hills and valleys. This dance style is a blend of Native American, African, and African-American cultures with the folk dance traditions of the British Isles. It is danced to lively Old Time Appalachian fiddle and banjo music.

We'll explore some basic steps like chugs, slides, the Tennessee Walking Step, and combine them into rhythmic phrases. It's a lot of fun for folks of all ages—from kids to grandparents. Here's a little taste of the foot-tappin' fun! Instructor Linda Wickenden has taught Appalachian clogging and flatfooting for many years. She has performed throughout Vermont and competed as a musician and dancer at the West Virginia Appalachian String Band Music Festival (known as "Clifftop").

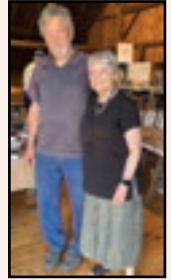

This ensemble of local musicians features music of the Baroque and contemporary women composers, played on the oboe, clarinet, and bassoon. Experience the Calamellus Trio in an intimate chamber concert that brings rich, layered sound to our island community. This is the first appearance of Calamellus at the Island Arts Summer Arts Festival.
